As per the advisory issued by Ministry of Home Affairs on Cybercrime Ecosystem Management (Ref. letter No. 22003/02/2019-CIS-II dated 27.06.2019), Gujarat Technological University, Ahmedabad was selected as a Local ISEA participating institute of C-DAC, Hyderabad to conduct the Cyber Safety and Security Week in association with Gujarat Police.




