Topics included:

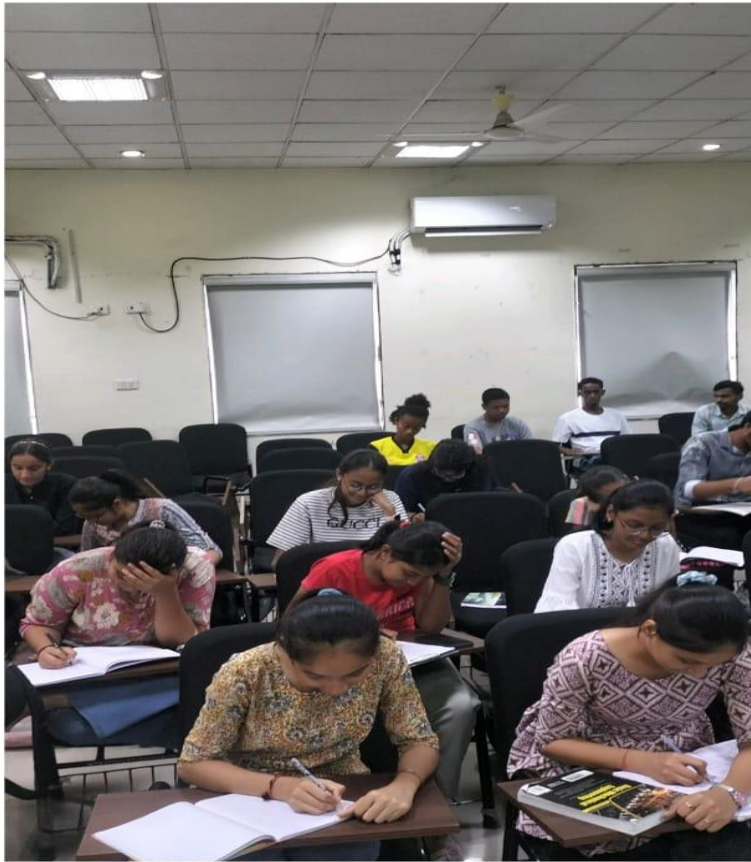
1. Space Education & Innovation
